 - Will Teresa need the shoes herself before Monday?
 - Does she have another pair at home just in case?
 - Will Kristyn be able to replace the shoes if something happens to them?
 - Is Kristyn careful and responsible with her own things?
 - What will happen to their friendship if Teresa does not lend the shoes to Kristyn?
 - What will happen to their friendship if Kristyn ruins or does not return the shoes?
- b) The math club is having a bake sale after lunch. Kolton wants a cupcake but doesn't have any money, so he asked his friend Zach if he could borrow some money for a cupcake. What should Zach consider before making this lending decision?
 - Will Zach have enough money to buy himself a cupcake if he lends some money to Kolton?
 - Does Zach need his extra money for something else?
 - Where will Kolton get the money to repay Zach?
 - Has Kolton borrowed money before? If so, did he pay the money back?
 - What will happen to their friendship if Zach does not lend Kolton the money?
 - What will happen to their friendship if Kolton does not pay Zach back?
