## **Possible Solution**


Billy won a prize at school. His teacher said that he would have two choices for the prize.

Choice 1: Get \$3 for the next 3 days.

Choice 2: Get \$2 for the next 5 days.


Which choice would Billy receive more money? Explain your thinking.

Choice 1: Get \$3 for the next 3 days.



3 + 3 + 3 = 93 groups of \$3 = \$9

Choice 2: Get \$2 for the next 5 days.



2 + 2 + 2 + 2 + 2 + 2 = 105 groups of \$2 = \$10

Which choice would Billy receive more money? Explain your thinking.

Billy would get more money with Choice 2 because that would be \$10, and Choice 1 would only be \$9.
