## Possible Solutions

Complete the following and justify your solutions using place value models or a number line.
a) 10 more than 239 is $\qquad$ .

When 10 is added to 239 , it now becomes 249 .
b) 100 less than 524 is $\qquad$ .

When taking away 100 from 524, it now becomes 424.
c) ___more than 352 is 362 .

When I add 10 to 352, it now becomes 362 .
d) Find a number that is more than 1023 and less than 1200.

A possible answer is 1030. The numbers become larger when increase to the right on a number line. so I looked to the right of 1023 and went to my next ten, 1030. 1030 is to the left of 1200 , so it is smaller than 1200.
e) Find a number that is more than 709 and has a 9 in the tens place.

I had a 0 in the tens place and I know I have to have a 9, so I had to move 9 tens on the number line to the right for a larger number.
