Hint
Lines must pass through at least two points.
Line segments begin at one point and end at another point.
A ray is named by its starting point, followed by the point through which it passes. You only need those two points to name the ray.

Angles are usually named by three points, a point on one ray, a vertex, and a point on the other ray.
Right angles usually have a box at the intersection of the perpendicular rays.
