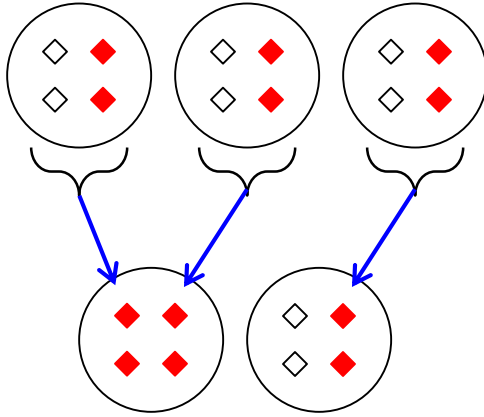


Possible Solutions

Using a Pictorial Model

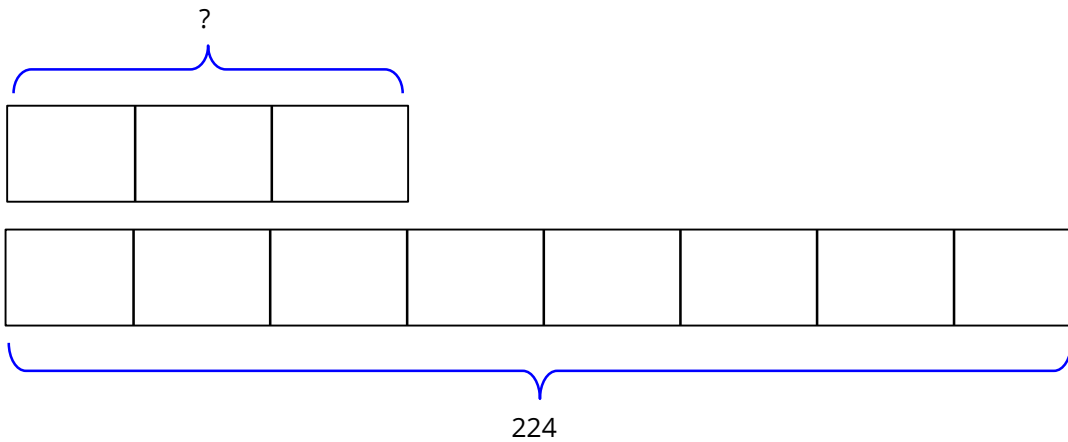
$$3 \times \frac{2}{4} \text{ (3 of the } \frac{2}{4}\text{)}$$



$$3 \times \frac{2}{4} = \frac{6}{4} = \frac{3}{2} = 1\frac{1}{2}$$

Using a Strip Diagram

$$\frac{3}{8} \times 224$$



$$8 \text{ units} = 224$$

$$1 \text{ unit} = 224 \div 8 = 28$$

$$3 \text{ units} = 3 \times 28 = 84$$

$$\frac{3}{8} \times 224 = 84$$
