Possible Solutions

The interesting part about this one is that there is not truly a correct answer. If a student can justify the answer they have chosen with proof based on their knowledge of each type of card, then it is correct. Here are a couple of examples:

- 1. John should use the credit card because he does not have money to purchase the shoes right now. If he gets paid before the credit card bill comes, he can directly pay them off with little to no interest. The credit card allows him to get it now and not have to wait.
- 2. John should use his debit card because it will automatically withdraw that amount from his account. If he uses a credit card, he would have to end up paying more for the shoes than if he bought them directly from his account.
