Hint

Students need to understand the model of a prism compared to a pyramid with equal bases and heights. The volume of pyramid is $\frac{1}{3}$ the volume of a prism with equal bases and heights.


Volume of Prism: $V=B h$, where B represents the area of the base and $h$ represents the height of the prism

Volume of a Pyramid: $V=\frac{1}{3} B h$, where $B$ represents the area of the base and $h$ represents the height of the pyramid
